March 18 – Meeting of Under 12 Directors & Biennale College Directors

An opportunity to get to know each other, share experiences, and begin to imagine the short films that will be produced.

Meeting dedicated to defining the concept, writing the screenplay, and preparing for filming.

March 26 – Meeting with the Production Teams

Official formation of the three working teams:

- Yellow Team
- Team Viola
- Orange Team

Each team will be made up of a director under 12, an Officina Pasolini graduate, a filmmaker from the Biennale College, a Festival producer, and actors from the schools.

March 28-30 – Short Film Shooting

The three teams begin shooting their short films with the technical support of Le Moscerine. Each team will follow a professional production path, from directing to editing. An immersive experience to transform the idea into cinematic reality.

April 10 – Press Conference at the Capitoline Hill

Official presentation of the Young Directors Grow project. Production team announcement and filming preview. Participation of institutions, media and professionals in the sector.

Moscerine Film Festival

The Moscerine Film Festival is an event dedicated to young cinema talents, with a particular focus on directors under 12.

Born with the aim of enhancing the creativity of children and promoting visual education, the festival has grown over the years to become a key event in the film scene dedicated to new generations.

In addition to the main competition, which allows children to see their short films screened on the big screen and receive feedback from industry professionals, the festival stands out for its strong commitment to inclusion and accessibility.

In its fourth edition, the festival expands its scope with the new "Young Directors Grow" section, a project that aims to build a bridge between the new generations and the professional world of cinema, pairing young talents with emerging directors from the Biennale College and graduates of the Officina Pasolini school.

The Moscerine Film Festival thus continues to grow, consolidating its position as a space for education, expression, and connection for young people who dream of making films.
